The Robert B. Carleson Eagle Fund was established in memory of a lifelong public servant, a close advisor to Ronald Reagan as Governor and President, and the father of welfare reform. Robert B. Carleson was an Eagle Scout who lived his life according to the principles of the Boy Scout Oath and Law, and who defended the Constitutional right of the Boy Scouts of America to maintain its membership standards without government coercion or forfeiture of corporate and public partnerships.
